Research Assistant

We are looking for a Research Assistant to work on multiple empirical projects related to Indian politics and society. This research is part of a larger agenda that seeks to understand mass attitudes in India on society and politics. The RA will work closely with Dr Omkar Joshi (University of Maryland, College Park) and Pranav Gupta (PhD candidate in Political Science, UC Berkeley).

This is a full time position. Initially, the selected candidate will work from home and subsequently the position will require working from Delhi.

Responsibilities:

Responsibilities include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Data management including data cleaning, merging etc.
- Exploratory data analysis
- Data visualisation
- Assistance in statistical inference
- Report writing

Qualifications:

- Graduate degree and/or proficient in data analysis.
- Knowledge of R (preferred), Stata, or Python.

Candidates from any field may apply. Interest in social sciences is desirable, but not required. Preference for candidates with prior experience of working with survey data.
